


Please join us for a dinner event benefiting **Prevent The Bite**, a 501c3 nonprofit organization devoted to reducing the incidence of dog bites to children through education.

Prevent The Bite is a 501c3 nonprofit organization devoted to reducing the incidence of dog bites to children. It was founded after Fremd student Kelly Voigt was attacked by a dog when she was seven years old. She received about 100 stitches in her face and throat and suffered from posttraumatic stress disorder and depression. Kelly's survival came with a determination to help keep other children safe from dog bites.

Sadly, what happened to Kelly is not uncommon. Dog bites are one of the top ten causes of injury to children. Over two million children are bitten by dogs every year in the United States, and most of their bites are in the face and neck. Dog bites account for more emergency room visits than skateboard, in-line skate, baby walker, all-terrain vehicle and horseback riding accidents combined.

- Dog bites account for one-third of all homeowner's insurance liability claims
 - Prevent The Bite information has been sent to all 60,000 members of the American Academy of Pediatrics and to every Post Office in the United States every year since 2004
- Current fundraising efforts will support the creation of a video to be used to educate children and guide Prevent The Bite educators through presentations

Our mission is to prevent dog bites to children through education.
